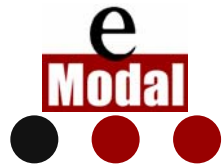

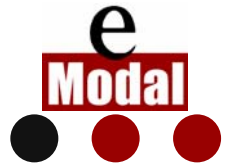
Congestion = Problem

4. Looking Back

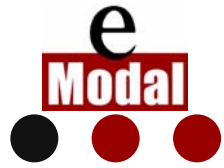

- ✓ It will take a “group effort” to fix it



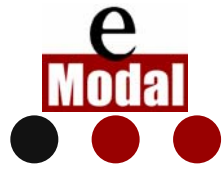
Addressing One Segment of Congestion

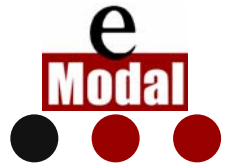
Marine Terminal Participation

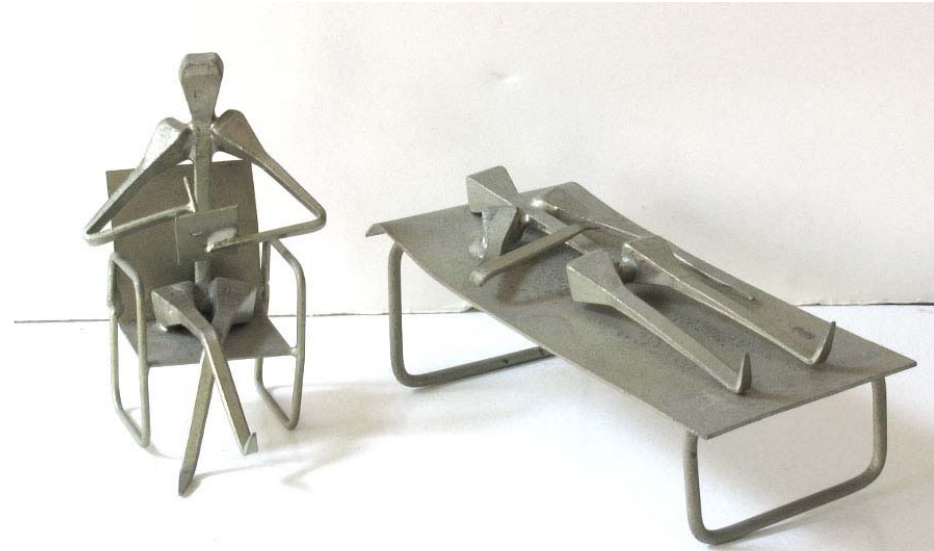

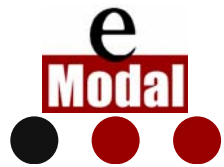

- ✓ Out-dated security and verification processes

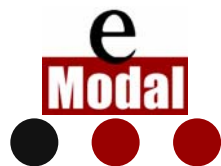

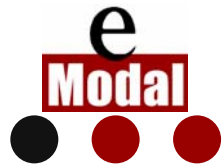


Step 4 Looking Back

- ✓ Increase industry-wide action

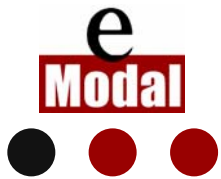
