




Our Mission



CBP's Enforcement Authorities

- CBP Field Operations' enforcement authorities at U.S. ports of entry encompass homeland security, travel, trade, and protecting U.S. agriculture.
- This broad authority allows for CBP officers to conduct searches of people and their baggage, cargo, and means of transportation to ensure all requirements for entry and exit are met.
- CBP enforces more than 400 laws at the border for more than 60 Federal agencies.






OFO Mission: Anti-terrorism

The Threat Remains...

While Mission Complexity Increases and External Demands Accelerate

- CBP is constantly refining and enhancing its anti-terrorism operations to combat evolving threats.
- As a result of the efforts of the CBP National Targeting Center and Immigration Advisory Program, 4,199 high risk travelers, who would have been found inadmissible, were prevented from boarding flights destined for the U.S.



OFO Mission: Facilitate Lawful Travel

In FY 2012, CBP Field Operations inspected more than 350 million travelers at 329 ports of entry.


OFO intercepted approximately **200,000 inadmissible aliens** at the POEs, and arrested more than **24,000 criminals**




OFO Mission: Cargo Security

- In FY 2012, CBP's Office of Field Operations processed nearly 25 million truck, rail, and sea containers.
- OFO secures and facilitates imports arriving in the U.S., accommodating growing volumes of trade in an increasingly complex global marketplace.
- CBP has established a strong foundation of partnerships with trade stakeholders and employs state-of-the-art non-intrusive inspection technologies to screen commercial traffic, facilitating the flow of legitimate trade.




OFO Mission: Seizing Contraband

In FY 2012, CBP Field Operations seized over **750,000 pounds of drugs**, **over 241,000 rounds of ammunition**, and **over \$65 million in currency**



OFO Mission: Trade Enforcement

In FY 2012, CBP Field Operations confiscated **over \$260 million in goods** and **\$156 million in intellectual property** through trade enforcement




OFO Mission: Agriculture Quarantine Inspection

In FY2012, CBP Field Operations intercepted more than **1.6 million prohibited animal and plant products** and prevented more than **173,000 agriculture pests** from entering the country
